Servcor sues Bayer, alleges fraud

Servcor International Inc., a Pinellas County roofing consultant, has filed a civil lawsuit seeking more than \$50 million in damages from **Bayer MaterialScience LLC** and two other companies for shutting it out of a contract with the **Miami-Dade Aviation Department**.

Servcor filed a lawsuit Feb. 5 in Pinellas circuit court alleging breach of contract, fraud and deceptive and unfair trade practices against Bayer, **Urethane of Kentuckiana Inc.** and **Mike Gomez Construction Consultants Inc.** of Miami, records show.

Servcor President David Looney alleges his firm took a contract to Bayer only to have it taken away by the company, said a statement.

The 32-count lawsuit alleges that Servcor and Bayer were business partners until a Bayer executive leaked confidential information after dinner and drinks to a Servcor competitor.

Attorney Daniel L. Moody of Moody and Shea PA represents Servcor.
